BENEFIT:

Faith Farm Ministries at its three campus locations provide three meals a day for over 400 program residents and staff members. Besides housing, more than 476,325 meals are provided throughout the course of a year. The 3 campus kitchens rely heavily on the equipment to produce the high volume of meals prepared each day. Operational commercial grade kitchen equipment, the purpose of our request, becomes a vital program component in the following three key ways:

1. Safe and healthy storage and preparation of large volumes of food is a requirement of any large volume dining facility.
2. This equipment aids in the quick cooking of volumes of food. This then requires less program residents involved in food preparation giving more time to the classroom part of the program. Similarly, the more efficient our kitchens, the less time spent by the remainder of the program residents away from work or the classroom in the dining facilities.
3. These meals are a key part of the physical healing of our program residents. As the program requires both work and classroom components combined with very little free time, meals are also a key morale aspect of the program. Our request will allow for storage and preparation of a greater range of food and add variety to the menu.

COST: \$156,000 with no fundraising or administrative fees.
