NEED STATEMENT: GRADUATE WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM SCHOLARSHIPS

DESCRIPTION: Faith Farm Workforce Development Programs for Graduate Students:

- **Extended Student / Fresh Start Program:** This is the first phase that graduates enter upon completion of the program. The student agrees to a 3 month commitment of service work on the Faith Farm campus. This is a time for students to strengthen their leadership skills and adjust into an extended program (see below) or that prepares the individual for re-entry into society. Our 3 career centers and ministry staff are available for resume building, job and housing search, interview skills, financial management education and other forms of assistance.
- **Advanced Student Programs:** This program is an additional one or two year educational, vocational and leadership training for the student.
- **Omega Work:** Omega Work allows a graduate to seek employment opportunities in the area near our 3 South Florida campus locations. They receive assistance in their job search, completing employment applications and resume writing. Graduates live on campus and have full meal privileges.
- **Omega School:** This program gives graduates the opportunity to acquire job certifications, continue their college started at Faith Farm, and/or training at local educational and trade institutions with scholarships for books and related expenses. Graduates live on campus and have full meal privileges.
- **Omega Military:** We are pleased to collaborate with recruiters from the various military branches to speak to our students and answer any questions. This option presents an amazing way for our students to give back to the nation; where in many instances they have not had a history of being good citizens.

BENEFIT: Faith Farm Ministries' mission is to instill and implement the best, most individualized set of tools for every man and woman who enters our program giving them the ability to succeed. The life-long struggle with addiction is not an overnight fix but requires an intense, long term recovery. We give our students the best we can offer them, and we are determined to see their lives changed. Transition through programs like these prepares graduates for their transition into the work force.
